

NEW 'BILLY ELLIOT' KAINE FIGHTS TO KEEP HIS PART



He may almost be dressed for the part but there's just no way Encore Ticket's Richard Woolliss is going to take over the role of 'Billy Elliot' from the new star, 12 year old Kaine Ward.

Kaine is the latest of 28 Billy Elliot's to have performed in the West End and 62nd around the world.
